

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITY PASSES

To enhance public support of Ellsworth School Department (ESD) Co-Curricular Activities (CCA), in addition to providing guidelines for the issuing of passes, the Ellsworth School Committee (ESC) establishes the following procedures.

- A. ESC members will be issued a photo identification at the time of their election, to be valid for the period of time they are elected to serve. This ID card will serve as identification for all CCAs and for entering ESD schools, after signing in with the school office in accordance with existing ESD policy requirements.
- B. Upon request, Ellsworth City Council Members and the City Manager will be issued a free "All Sports Pass" valid for the current school year.
- C. Upon request, members of the press will be issued a pass valid for all CCAs for the current school year. (Normally admitted by personal recognition)
- D. Upon request, any Senior Citizen sixty-two years (62) of age and over, and all former ESC members will be issued a free lifetime "All Sports Pass".
- E. Yearly "All Sports Passes" are available for purchase for persons under the age of sixty two (62). These passes will serve as admission to all ESD home sports events.
- F. Students may purchase "All Sports Passes" at the student price.
- G. ESD staff will be admitted by personal recognition.
- H. Passes issued by the Maine Principals' Association (MPA) will be honored as admission to all CCAs.
- I. All CCA admission fees are to be approved by the appropriate Building Administrator (BA).

NOTES:

Passes are available at the EHS Office, and/or the Director of Student Activities (DSA) Office.

Passes must be presented at the time of entry into the CCA, and will serve as admission to only the person named on the pass.

ESD passes are valid for ESD-sponsored activities only. (Not for MPA sponsored events)

The DSA and/or BA will design the passes which will be approved by the Superintendent.
